

PARTS OF SPEECH

There are eight parts of speech in the English language.
The part of speech indicates how a word functions in meaning as well as grammatically within a sentence.

PART	JOB	EXAMPLE
NOUNS	NAME OF A PERSON, PLACE, THING OR IDEA	ROAD, LADY, TREE, PEN, PHONE ETC
PRONOUNS	A TYPE OF WORD THAT REPLACES A NOUN	SHE, HE, IT, YOU, WE
VERBS	EXPRESS ACTION OR A STATE OF BEING	RAN, FLEW, JUMPED, IS, SHOWS
ADVERBS	A WORD THAT MODIFIES OR DESCRIBES AN ADJECTIVE, VERB ETC.	QUICKLY, SOFTLY, PRECISELY, SLOWLY
ADJECTIVES	DESCRIBES A NOUN	SHINY, THICK, FUNNY, OLD, NEW
PREPOSITIONS	FORM A RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN A NOUN AND THE REST OF THE SENTENCE	OVER, AROUND, DURING, THROUGH,
INTERJECTIONS	EXPRESS SURPRISE OR OTHER EMOTIONS	YIKES, UH-OH, UGH, OH BOY, OUCH
ARTICLES	HELP DEFINE NOUNS	AN, THE, A
